A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, ON THE 11th DAY OF MAY 2013, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE COUNCILMEMBERS.


