In accordance with Texas Election laws, this tabulation was made from the sealed election return sheets submitted to the Mayor by the Presiding Judge of the election precinct and the Early Voting Ballot Board of the election held on June 9, 2012. Also in accordance with Texas Election laws a recount for Position 1 was conducted on June 12, 2012 and finding no difference, the candidates for Position 1 cast lots resulting in Diana Newland as the declared winner. RESOLUTION NO 12- 14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE RUNOFF GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, ON THE 9th DAY OF JUNE 2012, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCILMEMBER POSITION 1 AND COUNCILMEMBER POSITION 2, AND CANVASSING THE RECOUNT FOR A TIE VOTE FOR COUNCIL POSITION 1 AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Webster, Texas in session, duly called the runoff general election to be held on the 9th day of June 2012, and the election returns of the 225 ballots cast in said election were canvassed for the following officials. Officials for the office of Councilmember Position 1 and Councilmember Position 2

WHEREAS, after duly canvassing said returns, the City Council finds that the votes at said election for the candidates for said offices are as follows.

WHEREAS, according to the Texas Election Code, Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 2.028 (a) if the recount does not resolve the tie, the tied candidates shall cast lots to determine the winner

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS

Section 1 That the results of said Runoff General City Election be and the same are hereby declared to have been as herein set out, and the following named persons had a tie vote and that an automatic recount according to the Texas Election Code was conducted on June 12, 2012 and the results being the same, the candidates for Councilmember Position 1 did cast lots to determine the winner The following named person did cast the winning dice and was elected to Councilmember Position 1 subject to the taking of their oath of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas and Charter of the City of Webster, Texas.





RESOLUTION NO. 12-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JUNE 9, 2012, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A COUNCILMEMBER AND/OR MEMBERS TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER; DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR SUCH ELECTION, PROVIDING THE FORM OF THE BALLOT AT SUCH ELECTION, DIRECTING THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS

Section 1 In accordance with the general laws, Constitution of the State of Texas and Article 6 04 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Webster, a Municipal Runoff Election is hereby called and ordered for the second Saturday in June, 2012, the same being the 9th day of said month, at which election all qualified voters of the City may vote for the purpose of electing the following officials of the City

RUNOFF GENERAL ELECTION

Council Member Position No 1

Council Member Position No 2

Section 2. The two candidates for such runoff election for Position No 1, shall be Edward Lapeyre and Diana Newland, same being the two candidates in the general election receiving the highest number of votes for Council Position No 1 The two candidates for such runoff election for Position No 2, shall be Carlos J Villagomez and Alexandra (Alex) Dietrich, same being the two candidates in the general election receiving the highest number of votes for Council Position No 2

Section 3 The present boundaries of the City constitute one election precinct which shall be designated Election Precinct "A" and includes all of Harris County election precinct nos. 91, 416,

655, 748, and 750 that lie within the city limits of the City of Webster. The polls shall be open for voting from seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. until seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. at the following polling place, and the following are hereby appointed officers to conduct the elections at said polling place

The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this resolution to each judge as written notice of their appointment as required by Section 32.009 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE.

The Presiding Judge shall have the authority to appoint at least two (2) clerks to assist in the holding of such election, but in no event shall the Presiding Judge appoint less than two (2) clerks. Unless otherwise required to act in the capacity of Presiding Judge, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall also serve as clerk of the election.

Each election official and clerk shall be compensated at a rate of \$10.00 for each hour worked at such election. The individual responsible for delivering the election returns after such election shall receive an additional sum of \$25.00.

Section 4 Pauline Small, City Secretary, is hereby appointed clerk for early voting; the

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appointment of a deputy clerk or clerks for early voting by the City Secretary shall be in accordance with Section 83.031 et seq of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE. The

is hereby designated as the place for early voting for such elections. Said clerks shall keep said office open during the hours that the City Secretary's main office is regularly open for business, that is from seven thirty o'clock (7:30) a.m. until five thirty o'clock (5:30) p.m., Monday through Thursday and seven thirty o'clock (7:30) a.m. until 11:30 o'clock (11:30) a.m. on Fridays for early voting which is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official state or federal holiday, beginning on May 29th and continuing through the fourth(4th) day preceding the date of such election. The early voting hours for the fifth (5th) day and fourth(4th) day preceding the date of the election shall be 12 hours, seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. until seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. Said clerks shall not permit anyone to vote early by personal appearance at any time when such office is not open to the public. The above described place for early voting is also the clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent. The early voting clerk, in accordance with the provision of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, shall maintain a roster listing each person who votes early by personal appearance and each person to whom a ballot to be voted by mail is sent. The roster shall be maintained in a form approved by the Secretary of State.

Section 5 Troy Stewart is hereby appointed as Presiding Judge of the Early Ballot Board.

In accordance with Section 87.001 et seq, TEXAS ELECTION CODE, said Presiding Judge shall

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appoint at least two (2) other members to said Board, and shall process early voting results in accordance with said TEXAS ELECTION CODE

Section 6 All ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the TEXAS ELECTION CODE. Paper ballots shall be used for early voting and for voting on election day In accordance with Section 61 012 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the City will provide in every polling place at least one voting station that is accessible to a voter with disabilities. All expenditures necessary for the conduct of the election and the purchase of materials therefor are hereby authorized.

Section 7 The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to furnish all necessary election supplies to conduct such election.

Section 8 The order in which the names of the candidates are to be printed on the ballot in the Municipal Runoff Election shall be determined by a drawing by the City Secretary, as provided by Section 52.094 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE. The City Secretary shall post a notice in her office of the date, hour, and place of drawing. Such notice shall remain posted continuously for twenty-four (24) hours immediately preceding the scheduled time of the drawing, and personal notice shall also be given to any candidate who makes written request for such notice and furnishes to the City Secretary a self-addressed, stamped envelope Each candidate involved in the drawing, or a designated representative, shall have a right to be present and observe the drawing.

Section 9 The candidate receiving a majority of votes in each of the positions to be filled in the Municipal Runoff Election shall be declared elected to such position.


Section 10 Notice of this election shall be given in accordance with the provision of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE and returns of such notice shall be made as provided for in said Code.

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The Mayor shall issue all necessary orders and writs for such elections, and returns of such election shall be made to the City Secretary immediately after the closing of the polls.

Section 12. Such election shall be held in accordance with the TEXAS ELECTION CODE and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.
