A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, ON THE 12th DAY OF MAY 2012, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO COUNCILMEMBERS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS




