**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF MAY, 1999, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND ONE COUNCILMEMEBER; AND CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE SAME DATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY CERTAIN PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE EXISTING CHARTER OF THE CITY.**

Section 1 That the results of said regular City election be and the same are hereby declared to have been as herein set out, and the following named persons were elected to the respective positions subject to the taking of their oaths of office as provided by the laws of the state of Texas and Charter of the City of Webster, Texas:

Section 2 That the results of said special City election be and the same are hereby declared to have been as herein set out, and Charter proposition Nos.1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 31, 33, 34, 35,36, 37, 38, and 41 passed. Said propositions shall become part of the Charter of the City of Webster, Texas, and it is hereby declared that each amendment to the Charter as fully set out in the ordinance calling said Charter amendment election is hereby adopted.

Section 3 The City Council of the City of Webster further finds that notice of said election was duly and properly given as required by law, and that said election was

duly held and returns thereof were duly made by the proper officials of said election and in all things according to law
