

RESOLUTION NO. 94-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN OFFICERS' ELECTION HELD ON THE 7TH DAY OF MAY, 1994.

WHEREAS, an Officers' Election was held in the City of Webster, Texas, on May 7, 1994, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Council Position No. 1, Council Position No. 2, and Council Position No. 6;

WHEREAS, all resident, qualified electors of the City of Webster were entitled to vote on the petitions; and

WHEREAS, 245 total votes were cast in said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the tabulation of votes cast in the general election held on the 7th day of May, 1994, made and certified to by the City Secretary of the City of Webster, Texas, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby adopted as the official tabulation of the votes cast at said election and that tabulation be filed and recorded in the official records of the City of Webster, Texas, as the official canvass of said election.

Section 2. That the said official canvass of the returns of the said election reflects the following:




Section 3. The necessity of making an official canvass of votes cast in the aforesaid election and declaring the said results of said election creates a public emergency and an imperative public necessity requiring the suspension of the Charter rule that no resolution shall be passed finally on the date of its introduction but that such resolution shall be read at two (2) meetings of the City Council, and the Mayor having declared such emergency and necessity to exist, having requested the suspension of the Charter rule and that this resolution take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, IT IS ACCORDINGLY SO ORDAINED.






