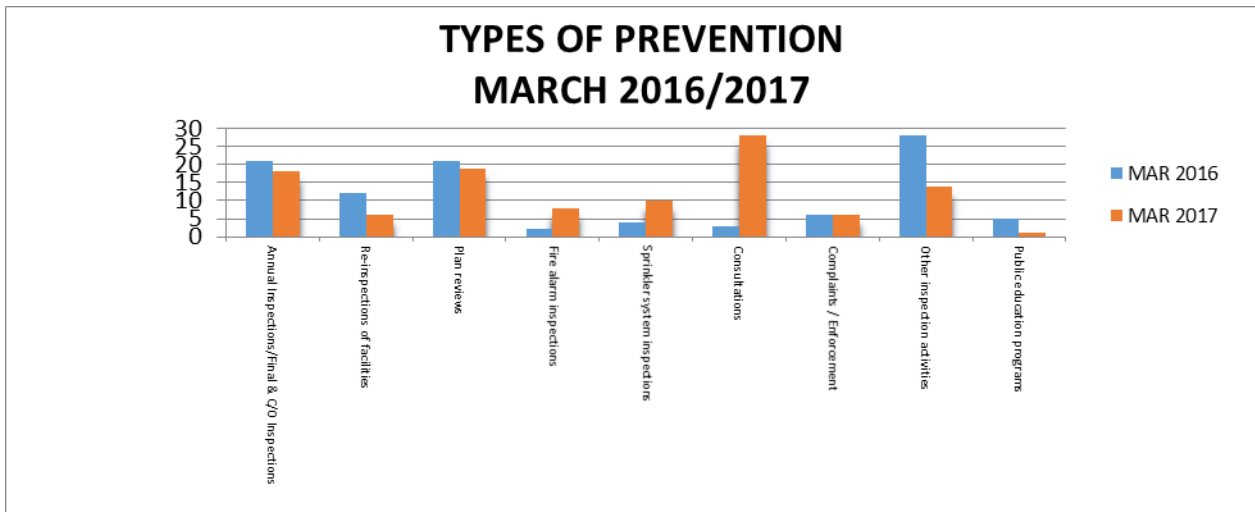


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

WFD – Special Operations Report - March 2017

Dive Response:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests during March 2017.

Training:

1. On March 16, 2017, the Webster Dive Team conducted training with the U. S. Coast Guard at Air Station-Houston on joint dive operations utilizing the Coast Guard's air assets.
2. The Webster Dive Team swim tests are scheduled April 8-9, 2017 for current team member recertification and for new members who have shown an interest in joining the team.

Meeting:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit Shift Commander and Coordinators met on March 20, 2017, to discuss upcoming dive classes and member selection appointments.

Car Seats:
