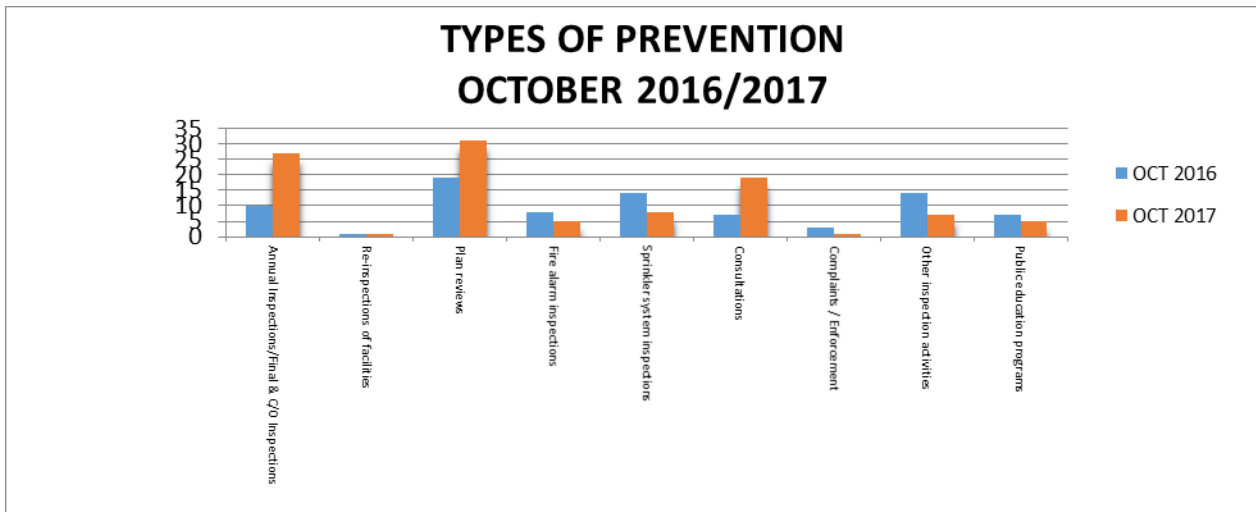


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE
