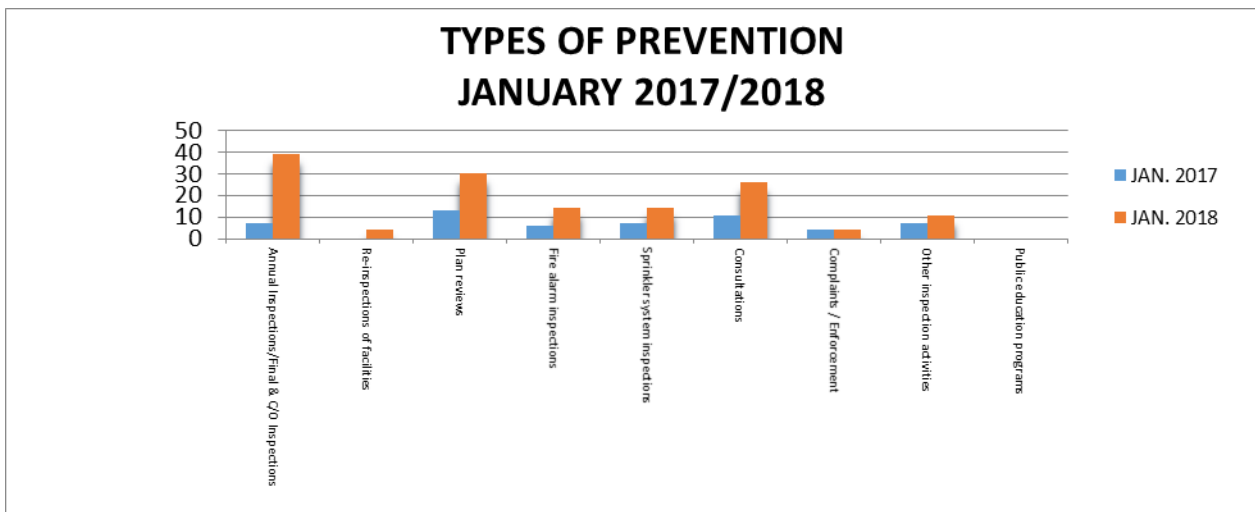


## FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

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## WFD – Special Operations Report - January 2018

### **Dive Response:**

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests for response during January 2018.

### **Training:**

1. As a continuation from previous monthly reports, the four (4) new dive team members have been outfitted with new dry suits, full-face masks, and communication equipment for their masks. Dry-fit testing has been completed. New team members are scheduled to test their new gear in a pool in February 2018, and follow that with open-water training in the near future. This new equipment warrants multiple-training evolutions in donning their new gear to ensure proper fit and appropriate connection between suit, mask and tank. Additional equipment to complete the PSD ensemble is currently in the purchasing process. Specific certification training in connection with this equipment is also scheduled during February 2018.

### **Meeting:**

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit leaders met and discussed upcoming training.

### **Car Seats:**

1. The Webster Fire Department CPS technicians assisted with three (3) car-seat installations during January 2018. Car-seat installations are handled as needed at the fire station, and through participation at special events held at the fire station and outside venues.
