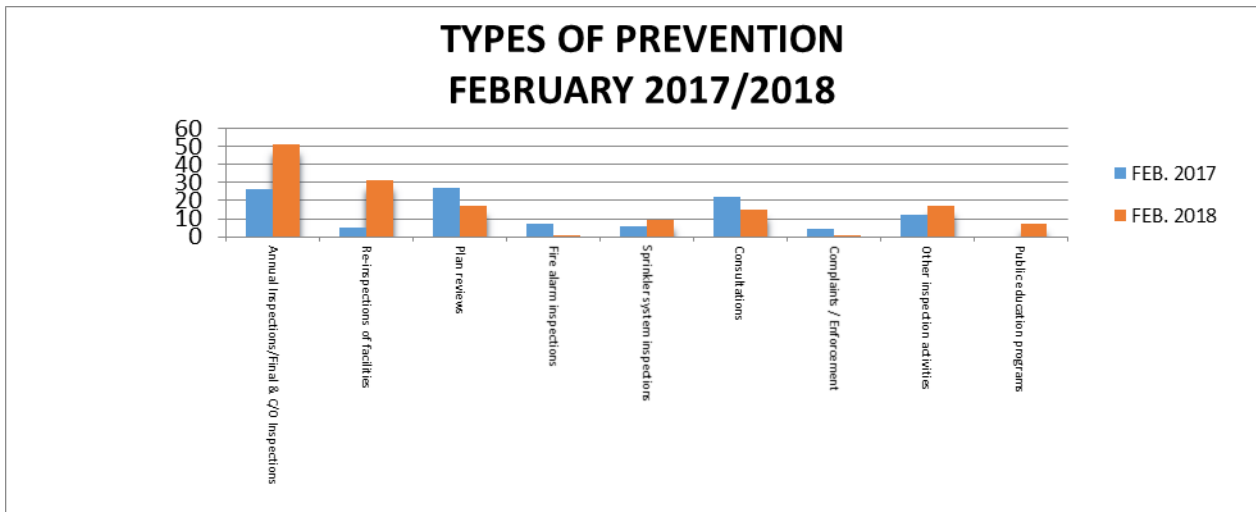


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

WFD – Special Operations Report - February 2018

Dive Response:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received one (1) request for response during February 2018.
