NEW BUSINESS

- **6. CONSIDERATION/ACTION** to approve a Pipeline Permit Application for Magellan Crude Oil Pipeline Company, LP that authorizes the construction, operation and maintenance of two (2) 26-inch underground crude oil pipelines that will connect into the Exxon Terminal (Tank Farm) facility located at the corner of NASA 1 Bypass and TX Highway 3 in the City of Webster, Texas.
- 7. CONSIDERATION/ACTION to authorize the Police Department to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Harris County Sheriff's Office for "freeway non-consent tows" as part of a regional "Tow and Go" program.
- **8. CONSIDERATION/ACTION** to approve and authorize the Mayor to execute an interlocal agreement with the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) Task Force for the purpose of fighting the illegal drug trafficking trade.

 - (2) on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with this chapter (regarding allegations by a former Public Works Department employee concerning his perceptions of the work environment at the Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Public Works Department and a potential administrative investigation to be conducted on behalf of the City Council as authorized by Section 3.12 of the City Charter).
