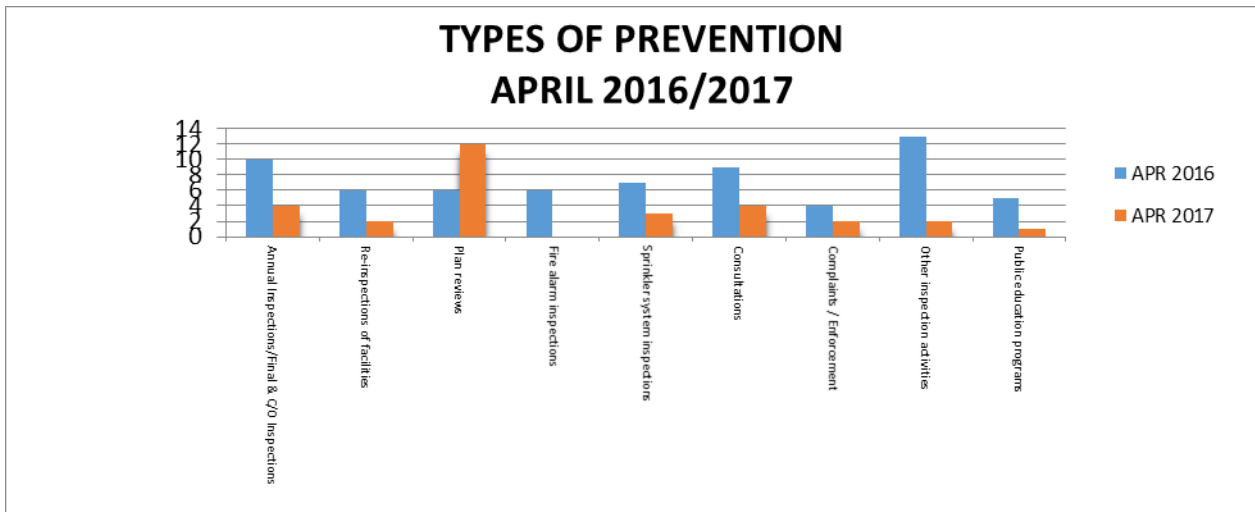


## FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

## WFD – Special Operations Report - April 2017

### **Dive Response:**

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests during April 2017.
2. A rescue demonstration was provided to the Webster Citizens Police Academy.
3. The City of Webster Take-Back-Medication Day was held at the Webster Fire Department on Saturday, April 29, 2017.

### **Training:**

1. The Dive Team conducted swim testing on Saturday, April 8, and Sunday, April 9, 2017. The event provided current team members with an opportunity to recertify and granted new participants with an occasion to test their skills. There are six (6) new prospective members.
2. Basic water rescue techniques were discussed. The use of throw retrieval ropes were demonstrated.
3. Donning and doffing of PFD's were practiced.

### **Meeting:**

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit Shift Commander and coordinators met during April 2017. They discussed training and projected budgetary needs. It was decided the budget requests for FY 2017-2018 remain unchanged.

### **Car Seats:**

1. The Webster Fire Department CPS technicians assisted with three (3) car-seat installations during April 2017. Car-seat installations are handled as needed at the fire station, and through participation at special events held at the fire station and outside venues.
