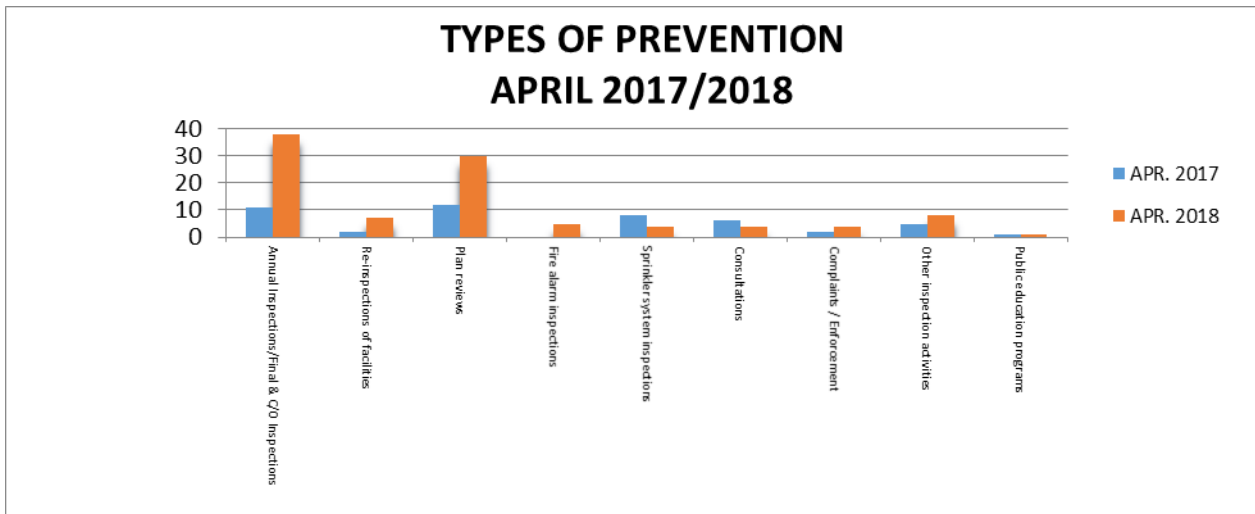


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

WFD – Special Operations Report - April 2018

Dive Response:

1. Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests for response during April 2018.

Training:

1. Webster Special Operations Unit conducted the following training during April 2018:
 - **April 5:** Dry suit and full mask lecture and pool training in La Porte, Texas, with Diving Unlimited International and Texas Dive Center; and
 - **April 12:** Dry suit and full mask pool training in La Porte, Texas, with Texas Dive Center for the four (4) new divers.
2. The following gear has been ordered and is awaiting delivery: hoses and regulators for the four (4) new divers.

Meeting:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit members met and discussed:
 - multi-city dive training exercises with LCVFD; and
 - policy and procedures.

Car Seats:

1. The Webster Fire Department CPS technicians assisted with six (6) car-seat installations during April 2018. Car-seat installations are handled as needed at the fire station, and through participation at special events held at the fire station and outside venues.
